
Identifying Mobulid Ray Gill Plates

Is the gill plate longer than 30cm and uniform brown/black in coloration?




Manta rays | Mobula birostris & M. alfredi

- **1. SIZE** = medium/large (usually more than 30cm)
- **2. COLOUR** = uniform brown/black (rarely white)
- **3. LOBE EDGING** = smooth


Question 2:

Does the gill plate have a white central coloration and smooth lobe edging?



Sicklefin Devil Ray Mobula tarapacana

- **1. SIZE** = medium
- **2. COLOUR** = bicoloured (white central)
- **3. LOBE EDGING** = smooth





Spinetail Devil Ray Mobula mobular

- **1. SIZE** = small/medium
- **2. COLOUR** = bicoloured (white edging)
- **3. LOBE EDGING** = jagged
